A message from Bernadette O'Shea Managing Director, Triathlon Homes



Triathlon Homes owns almost 50% of all the homes in East Village. We are proud of the fact that we can provide a range of affordable homes for Londoners. Our job is to ensure that all our residents are able to enjoy warm, safe, well maintained homes in this unique setting. There is nowhere else like this in London.

Everything we deliver to you is managed through our partners and hopefully you are becoming familiar with the names, the faces and the roles. Let me introduce them:

- East Homes delivers the housing management service for Triathlon Homes; from a small base in the village they organize the lets; collect the rent; deal with day to day tenancy matters and liaise with other agencies to ensure the needs of residents are catered for.
- East Village Management Limited is a jointly owned company (with QDD who own all the other properties in the village); EVML is sometimes known as Team East and they are responsible for all the management and maintenance of the 'common parts' and the 'public realm'. We work in close liaison with EVML to ensure you get value for money for the service charge.
- Defects Ltd; this is a specialist provider who has been managing the defects process for us over the last two years. We have now commissioned them to oversee the 'end of defects' process, this is a rolling programme of final visits to all the Triathlon Homes to ensure that all defects from the original build have been identified and dealt with. Once this is complete all day to day maintenance inside your homes will be facilitated by East Homes and their specialist contractor 'Interserve'.

We also work closely with Get Living London to support community activities in the village and ensure joined up communications with all residents. Our vision is to create a place where everyone feels included and where there are numerous opportunities to socialize with each other...just like a typical village.

From my perspective I have to acknowledge that we have had some challenges in the first year: communicating effectively with everyone; ensuring that residents in the intermediate market rented homes understand their contracts; responding to concerns about the heating system and noise nuisance. So there have been challenges. Some of these matters are on-going so we need to continue with improvements.

I have been in post for just over a year and I have witnessed the village as it has come alive. The most important part of that has been the active engagement of residents themselves. I have never before seen such an array of activities and groups; the energy in the village is fantastic and hopefully infectious.

I hope you share my view that the village is a great place to live, I am certainly very proud of all that has been achieved.










Our Residents
